Back to the drawing board

Cockram Construction had been utilising its own in-house project control system for the past 20 years. However, this product had become inefficient and was very slow for the steadily growing company. "We were having to put a lot of resources into its maintenance," says Darren. "We made a decision that it was time to change from that and go with a recognised industry package that was developed and maintained and supported outside of our business."

Perfecting the design

As a system that would be used by over 150 employees, Cockram were driven to provide their team with a high-quality management system that was reliable and easy to use.
